

## "Slain in the Spirit"?

Question: "I know of a Christian friend who was 'slain in the Spirit' by his pastor during a recent church service. What do you make out of this phenomenon?"



This is a puzzling observation. In recent years, there have been a resurgence of emotionalism, esctaticism and mysticism in modern worship. The phenomenon of being 'slain in the Spirit' is one of them. Ronnie Howard Brownie, the notorious Holy Laughter advocate did these to a mass of worshippers in the Indoor Stadium when he was in Singapore in 1994 at the so-called 'Toronto Blessings'.

It is important to note that our sole authority for appraising any spiritual phenomena or movement must be based on the infallible standards of God's holy and un-changing Word. It is observed that this phenomenon of being 'slain in the Spirit' resulted in 'believers' (I write this with concern and caution, giving them the benefit of doubt) falling backward often unconscious, shaking violently as one with fits for some which is very shocking. In some cases, like the so-called Toronto Blessings, some were barking with animal's noises like dogs or hooting like owls. This is an enigmatic phenomenon that is quite outlandish. The Bible has record of people falling before the Lord. It is instructive to note that they did not lose consciousness nor faint, rather they consciously bowed before the Lord (ie forward) in holy worship and awe. Consider the following biblical facts in the Old and New Testament:

Gen 17:3	Abraham fell face down.
Deut 16:4	Moses fell face down.
Deut 9:18-29	Moses fell prostrate (ie forward) and prayed.
Josh 5:14	Joshua fell in reverence.

Jud 13:21 Samson's parents fell face down.

O come, let us
worship and bow down:
let us kneel before
the LORD our maker.
Psalm 95:6



It is noteworthy that all these regenerate men fell forward in awe, reverence and worship the Almighty Lord consciously. None were in a godless delirium or in

a semi-hypnotic state of consciousness or did they fall backwards. The Holy Spirit present in true worship is a Spirit of orderliness not of chaos and confusion. (1Cor 14:40) This is highly significant from a theological point of view.

#### What about people falling backward in the Bible?

Yes, there were. One of them was Goliath the Philistine in 1Sam 17:49 who fell



backward after 'being struck with a stone by David (and later died). Then we have Eli in 1Sam 4:18 who fell backward and broke his neck and died after hearing the sad news about his wayward sons.

In the New Testament, we have the Roman soldiers who came to arrest Jesus, when our Lord said, 'I am' they all fell backward (John 18:6). Another occasion was in Acts 5:1-11 when Ananias and Sapphira fell to the ground and died when the judgment of the Apostle Peter was pronounced. In all these instances, it is noteworthy that their salvation were questionable (NB that does not mean that a believer cannot be deceived and manipulated by others in the short run; it is still possible if we allow them to.)

In summary, we have briefly examined the

modern day phenomenon of so-called being slain in the spirit, that was and is still practised in some churches which includes falling backward (sometimes with catchers behind you and ready towels to cover the ladies too which is quite extra-ordinary,) is uncommon and semi-conscious state as a strange and puzzling experience that is not normative for believers in both the OT and NT (except for some unbelievers) as discussed above.

Ture revival comes with the preaching of gospel of Christ leading to true evangelical repentance of sins and we see not of this in the Slained in the Spriit phenomenon .Our Lord Jesus and the Apostles never promoted nor wrote about 'being slain in the Spirit' nor prescribed it as a normative practice for

the NT believers in the churches .With due respect to the proponents of this practice, one has to conclude objectively that there is no biblical warrant or precedent for such a phenomenon to be practised in our Biblebelieving God-honouring churches today. Hope this helps.
