## "Typology of the Passover Lamb" (Exo 12:1-27) Sermon by Pastor Jack


- A Summary -

## 1. Preparation of the Lamb (vs 1-4)

- This event in Exo 12 affected the calendar of Israel as "This month shall be unto you the beginning of months".
- it also marked the beginning of the new year for the Jewish people.
- The book of Isaiah in Isa 53 speaks of a lamb & a sheep led to the slaughter, a very rich typology of the death and burial of Christ.
- The nature of a sheep is that it is harmless, humble and totally defenceless.
- The Gospel of John speaks of the Lamb of God that takes way the sin of the world. (Jn 8:12).

## 2. Properties of the Lamb (vs 5-11)

- The lamb sacrificed by the Israelites on that night was required to have certain qualities:
  - o without blemish ie not sick or lame
  - a male (there is a cult group, called the Eastern Lightning, from China that propagates that Christ is female and other defective practices)
  - o not more than 2 years old (ie in the prime of its life. Christ was in the prime me of His life when He begin His ministry).
- Heb 11:28 says, "Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them."
- "Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast with fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof. And ye shall let nothing of it remain until the morning; and that which remaineth of it until the morning ye shall burn with fire." Someone said, "if He is not Lord of all, He is not Lord at all."



- "And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD's Passover." Christ is our Passover, and this is the rich typology here.
- Paul in 1Cor 5:7 says, "Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us." The Passover feast is to be taken with sincerity, truth and faith in Christ for "without the shedding of blood, there is no remission of sin."

## 3. Pre-figuring & Power of the Lamb (vs 12-24)

- The Passover lamb was a picture of our Lord Jesus Christ who was the Lamb of God:
  - The lamb was a substitute for the first born who had to be killed.
  - A yearling cut off in the prime of life.
  - Had to be perfect ie as flawless for our Lord is sinless.
  - o Taken from the flock ie from among the Jewish people.
  - To be Separate from the flock.
- We have the protection of the Lamb from the destroyer
- The Blood of the Lamb delivers us from sin, hell and the grave eternally.

#### Conclusion

The Old Testament is rich in figures of speech, and the passover lamb prefigured Christ as a rich typology who came as the true Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world.

Do you know Christ as your Lord and Savour? Seek Him today as your God while he may be found and be saved before it is too late
