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Precepts for the Prudent Use of our Tongue

There are many practical insights found in the universal epistles of the New Testament. The whole book of James talks about *A Belief that*



Behaves (ie. good Christian conduct after being saved). Chapter 3:1-12 warns us that our tongue can be a powerful weapon for good or evil speech, and it must be controlled and sanctified to show that we have been saved as we have turned away from spiritual darkness into the light of salvation. Prov 10:11 says "The mouth of a righteous man is a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked."

There is an old Arab proverb which says,

"Of your *Unspoken* words, you are a *Master*, of your *Spoken* words, you are a *Servant*, of your *Written* words, you are a *Slave*."

We relate to one another through our actions, words and body language and now with modern technology through our handphones, WhatsApp, mass and social media (Facebook, Instagram and Tik Tok) and emails. The Interpersonal communication (include electronic means) through the verbal means among Christians and even non-believers is an important aspect of social life. **Words can heal and it can hurt; it can be a blessing to the souls or a curse to the hearers. Beware of using unedifying**

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. **Proverbs 18:21**



words with an evil intent. Prov 10:13 says, "In the lips of him that hath understanding wisdom is found: but a rod is for the back of him that is void of understanding."

James in chapter 3:2-8 talks about the great destructive power of the tongue (verses 5 and 6 compared the tongue to fire!) Note the seven great iniquities that the tongue can commit that we need to be wary of:

- Flattery, as opposed to honest and measured commendation for the deserving before God.
- b) Beware of modern-day worldly deception. Do not prevaricate from the truth and do not be presumptuous and pretend to know when we do not. Let your yea be yea, your nay be nay.
- c) Do not be given to slander. Do not speak evil of others with malevolent intent or make suggestive remarks to undermine others.

d) Be careful of gossip, back-biting, murmuring, tale-bearing. Be very careful

about what you pass around by word of mouth or even through other forms of electronic communication. It may come back to haunt you one day.

- e) Beware of unedifying complaints. Negative criticism like the children of Israel entering the Promised Land who murmured against God's given manna and were consumed by fire (Num 11:1-11).
- f) Be careful not to use threats and verbal abuse; Eph 6:4 added, parents do not provoke your children unto anger with harsh or sarcastic words.
- g) Do not engage in unedifying debate that adds up to nothing with words of anger or malice.



The Edifying Use of Our Tongue

James in chapter 3:9-12 talks about the uses and privileges of a well-ordered tongue. They are:


- a) To be used in Thanksgiving to God in prayer
- b) Worship and Praise (singing) of God when we sing hymns and read His Word
- c) **Encouragement** and **Edification** when we encourage and exhort one another.
- d) Praying for one with others believing God for His mercies and grace.
- e) Witnessing, Teaching and Preaching of the Word when we share the gospel of Christ with others.
- f) Words of Consolation and Solace/Comfort when we strengthen one another in times of bereavement or distress
- g) 1Peter 13:15 says, 'But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear.' Always be Ready to Give an Answer of the Hope that is in us with our lips to unbelievers.


Application and Reflection

James 3:13-18 says,

Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.'

True biblical wisdom is not only what we know but who we really are inside and what we say to others as well. For every word that we are about to say, there should be 4 sentinels or rules that should govern our speech before we let it out of our mouths:





- 2. **Charity** (Is it said out of love or hatred with an evil intent?)
- 3. **Verity** (Is it true or it is just a conjecture?)
- 4. **Necessity** (Must I say it, and must it be now?)

We should always watch the Extent

We should always watch the Extent, Content and Intent of our speech. Paul in Colossians 4:6 says, "Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man." Every organ of our body is to be sanctified by the Lord as Romans 6:19 says, 'I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.' Ask the Lord to cleanse and purge us from all our sins.

Conclusion

THINK

Col 4:6 says, 'Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.' Finally, we are all vulnerable to sin through our lips daily. There is a Chinese idiom which says that words once spoken, the best galloping horse cannot bring it back. We need to pray and ask God for guidance and for wisdom to discipline ourselves as we let the Holy Spirit control our tongue. If you are a non-believer, first of all, you need to believe and accept Jesus as your personal Saviour and Lord and confess and repent of our sins, then you can have edifying and wholesome speech by the power of the Holy Spirit that is acceptable to God.

DR RON NELLER holds a B.A. (Hons) and a Ph.D., both in fluvial geomorphology. He has held lecturing and research positions at the University of New England (Australia), Griffith University, the University of Sunshine Coast (Queensland), the University of Queensland, Turku University (Finland), and The Chinese University of Hong Kong (People's Republic of China). He has also initiated and directed a research institute in environmental sustainability and established two research stations in natural resource management.

While in these positions Ron undertook landscape studies in Australia, China, Finland, Peru, The Pacific Islands, and Libya. He held numerous government advisory positions with the Queensland Government and the Federal Government of Australia in natural heritage management as well as working with international agencies such as the OECD. Ron stepped down from university involvement in 2008 to launch a consultancy business.

Ron was an occasional church goer through parts of his life, but only gave his life to Christ in his early 50s. Although Ron was not a Christian in his earlier years, he was also not a supporter of geological evolution. His research suggested otherwise. Indeed, it was only upon becoming a Christian that his data (derived from decades of research on landscape change) finally started to make sense. He then commenced to speak at local churches about this journey to the acceptance of the Bible's history regarding origins and the Flood of Noah, and faith in Christ.
